1. Identify a goal that you have for your future, and provide a detailed explanation of how you plan to achieve this goal.
2. Describe how you see yourself making the transition from middle school into high school, and identify how faculty and students at Seton Keough can help ease this transition.
3. Explain how the person you are as an eighth grader differs from the person you were as a sixth grader, focusing on why this change is beneficial.
4. Imagine that four years have passed, and you are writing a reflection about your years spent at Seton Keough. Explain what you hope to be able to say about your four years at Seton Keough.
